ALBRIGHTON PARISH COUNCIL MINUTES OF MEETING

Minutes of the Albrighton Parish Council planning meeting held on 3rd November 2016 at 7.15 pm in the council meeting room,

PRESENT: Cllrs. S Kirkland (Vice Chair), D Beechey, P Griffin, C Hassall, P Illes, C Roseby, A Straney, P Woodman.

In attendance: M Ward, Clerk to Albrighton Parish Council.

In the absence of the Chairman of Council Cllr. Kirkland chaired the meeting.

PUBLIC SESSION:

Two members of the public were present who wished to raise concerns regarding planning application 16/04356/FUL. They felt that the new suggested housing would overlook their property in the Limes, undermine their security, take light from their estate and the removal of asbestos in the garages in Ashgrove was a health threat. They would have been less concerned if the new housing had been single storey but if it was to be conventional housing they would need a high fence building between them and the present garages. The proposed development had caused them and their neighbours considerable stress.

Cllr. Woodman stated that this was an application for lawful development and there were no details available to the council for them to form an opinion as to its suitability. The council declined to form a view on this matter.

Cllr. Woodman stated that he had been in touch with one of the planning team at Shropshire Council and he felt that overall the proposed development was beneficial to the area. There was discussion as to the wisdom of seeking opinions from the planners when the council was being asked for its own opinion and Cllr. Hassall felt that it was ill advised and should not be repeated. Cllr Woodman disagreed stating that it was perfectly reasonable for a Councillor to consult the planners as experts so as to formulate an advised report to enable the council to reach its decision.

Members discussed the issue of whether the building of houses rather than bungalows invalidated the application and of the impact on close neighbours living in The Limes, particularly as the new properties would overlook bedrooms.

Cllr. Woodman proposed that the application should be supported by the council but the issues that had been raised by the public and in discussion in council should be relayed to the planning authority. Cllr. Griffin seconded the motion which was tied 3-3 with one abstention. Cllr. Kirkland gave her casting vote in support of the application.

Cllr. Beechey had looked into this application and could find no justifiable reason why the section 106 payment should be reduced or removed.

Cllr. Beechey proposed that the application should be rejected which was seconded by Cllr. Roseby and unanimously approved by council.

Cllr. Woodman proposed that the council should give their support to the application which was seconded by Cllr. Illes and agreed by council 5-1 with 1 abstention.

4. TO RESPOND TO THE REQUEST FROM SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL REGARDING THE COMMUNITY RIGHT TO BID.

Members considered the email received from Mr Steve Law of Shropshire Council seeking the views of the council on the possible listing of the Sports and Social Club in Loak Road, Albrighton as an asset of community value. Members felt that the club met all of the criteria mentioned in the report and it was undoubtedly an organisation that was active and valued by many members of the community.

Cllr. Kirkland proposed that the council should give its support to the application to be listed as an asset of community value which was seconded by Cllr. Illes and unanimously agreed by council.

5. TO RESPOND TO THE NOTIFICATION FROM BRITISH TELECOMMUNICATIONS OF THEIR PROPOSAL TO REMOVE THREE TELEPHONE BOXES IN THE ALBRIGHTON AREA.

Members noted that one telephone box in Shackerley Lane was within the boundary of Donington with Boscobel Parish Council and therefore not their legitimate concern. The other two were both being used and the one in the High Street was clearly catering for a need with 140 calls within the last twelve months. The convenience of phone boxes also impacted on emergency use and helping those residents with mobility problems.

Cllr. Woodman proposed that the telephone boxes in Bowling Green Lane and the High Street should not be removed which was seconded by Cllr. Griffin and agreed by council 6-0 with 1 abstention.

6. TO DECIDE ON A DATE FOR THE DECEMBER PLANNING MEETING.

Cllr. Kirkland informed members that the next planning meeting coincided with the Albrighton Traders' Christmas Extravaganza and members agreed to move the meeting to Wednesday 30th November in order that councillors could give their support to this important annual event.

No additional items for the business meeting on 17th November were identified.

8. CORRESPONDENCE:

For action:

• Martin Sutton – recommendation for the treatment of a damaged tree by the bus stop in Albrighton High Street.

Councillors considered the two options presented by the County Arboriculturalist regarding the damaged plane tree next to the bus shelter in the High Street relating to either its removal or for further pollarding. They noted that the state of the tree was described as 'appalling' and the fact that it was unlikely to ever prosper.

Cllr. Illes proposed that the tree should be removed and replaced by a 'cockspur' type hawthorn as recommended by Mr Sutton which was seconded by Cllr. Woodman and unanimously agreed by council.
