No Smoking Policy

This Policy is intended to:

- protect everyone against the effects of second-hand smoke
- promote health in the workforce and community
- support those people who would like to quit smoking

This Policy is being written with the employees', users', visitors' and contractors' best interests in mind. The right of people to breathe clean air prevails over the right of the smoker to smoke.

Albrighton Parish Council does not allow smoking in any part of its premises, grounds or vehicles. There will be no ashtrays inside its buildings or vehicles. Employees are not expected to smoke when attending meetings or other events where smoking is permitted. Signs will be displayed where necessary to inform visitors of this Policy.
